Principal's Corner:

- In-person learning- coming back safely:
 - K thru 2nd- Safety video will be sent out to parents on Wed 21st.
 - Kids will follow social distancing protocols and wear their masks while in school. One way only hallways have been set up.
 - No temperature will be taken at the beginning of the day, If kids appear to be sick but have any preexisting conditions and no fever, the child may go back to class. If no record of preexisting conditions, the child will be isolated with an adult until parent comes to pick up them up.
 - 8:20 am is the beginning of drop off as the cafeteria will not be open to receive students earlier. Teacher will receive the kids and walk them into their classroom to respect the 6 feet distancing rule.
 - Each classroom will have a specific snack time. The cafeteria will have 10 open tables to seat 20 children at a time. No masks while eating.
 - While in the playground, children will wear their masks. However, teachers will provide mask breaks as needed for the group respecting social distancing protocols for safety.
 - Hand washing and use of sanitizer will be enforced throughout the day- morning arrival, before and after snack, after playground, etc.
 - Sack breakfasts and lunches will be provided to all students by the district for the next day. Given at 12:30 pm as they leave.
 - Bathrooms: only one student at a time. They will be separated by using A or B day cards and will have to wait for turn if another student is already using the facilities.



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- School materials should remain at home. Please provide a 2nd set of materials for school as there will be no sharing (pens, markers, folders, etc.). Each student will have their own basket to keep their things separately. If assistance is needed, please contact the principal.
- Parents Q&A:
 - When students enter the building kids will know their teacher's name and adults will guide kids to their respective classrooms.
 - Pickup: Kindergarten parents will pick up by the Kindergarten gate, all other kids will leave from the main doors. Respect social distancing while waiting.
 - Right at School program will begin on Oct.26th for after school care only. During "home" days, Right at School will confirm where the students will be received.
 - If parents change their minds regarding the hybrid program, the plan could be adjusted for the student(s). However, it is not encouraged due to staffing logistics.
 - If at any point any of the 3 counties that are part of the district (DuPage, Kane, Cook) go red due to their Covid-19 numbers, the whole district will go back to full e-learning.
